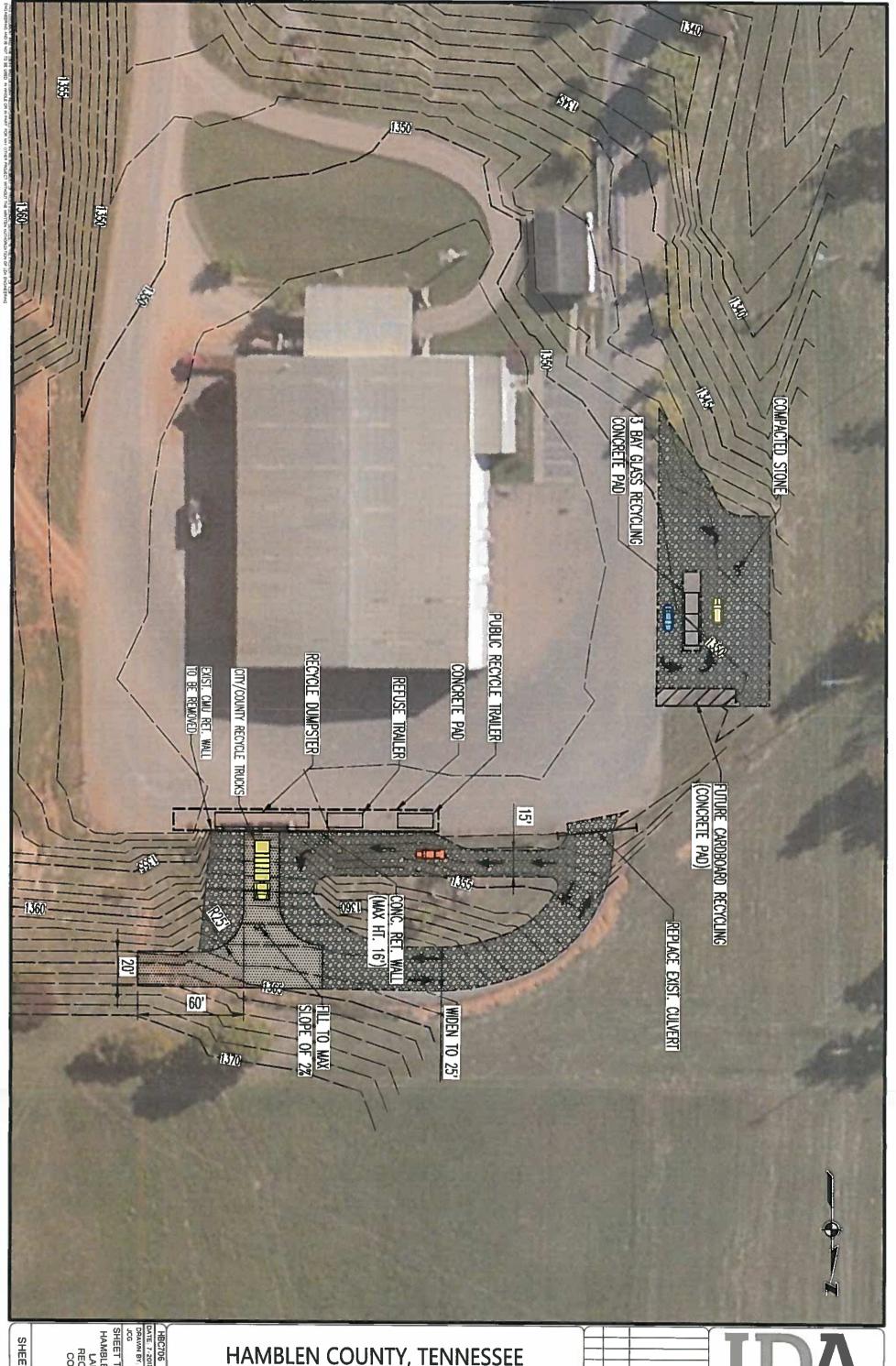
WHEREAS, the "Authority" has indicated its intention to make major capital improvements at its landfill to build the convenience center to support recycling efforts; and

Midsouth Solutions also known as Summit Uniforms was asked to provide this department with a few sets of patrol uniforms to include boots. They required us to pay for the entire order up front but many items were backordered.

Each time backorders were shipped they invoiced us again although those items were already paid for. They actually sent **PAST DUE** notices for items already paid for.

Debbie and Dennis in Accounts Payable were required to spend an inordinate amount of time trying to resolve Summit's billing issues and in the end it took them almost six months to get everything straightened out.

We sent a few officers to Summit's place of business who were measured by Summit for uniforms and when they shipped the uniforms they did not fit at all and had to be redone.

We sent an officer to Summit to be measured for boots **prior** to him entering the academy (TLETA), that officer's boots never arrived until **after** he had graduated from the 10 week academy.

We then turned to TruBlu Tactical and everything we needed was received in less than three weeks with no billing issues.

I have also spoken to other agencies who have dealt with Summit in the past who say they were unhappy with billing issues and delayed shipping.

For them as a vendor to try to provide 55 Corrections Officers with uniforms and boots when they cannot handle just a few would be disastrous for us and impossible for them based on their past poor performances.

It is in the best interest of the County to not accept this bid and to go with TruBlu Tactical.

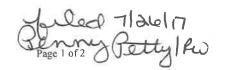

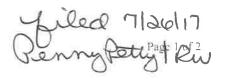

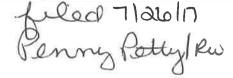

I was recently contacted by Tim Planer, who is the Residential Building Supervisor for the State of Tennessee. I was questioned as to why Hamblen County had the North Carolina Building Codes listed as being used in part of the Inspection process. In the past, these Codes were in fact used for Accessibility guidelines for Building Inspectors. When the 2012 International Building Codes were adopted by Hamblen County and went into effect in June of 2015, the North Carolina Codes became obsolete to Hamblen County. The 2012 Building Codes refer to the ICC/ANSI A117.1-2003 for all accessibility guidelines. Mr. Planer suggested that Hamblen County remove the North Carolina Building Codes from being listed in association with Hamblen County.

I would recommend that the North Carolina Building Codes be removed where it is listed for use in regards to building in Hamblen County.

Re: Hamblen County EMS Services Board Recommendation

Hamblen County EMS Regulatory Board (HCERB), based on the Resolution and Regulations of operation of patient transport within Hamblen County, unanimously recommends Morristown Hamblen EMS to be made sole provider of EMS services in Hamblen County with no limit on the duration of time on the Certificate of Authority to Operate until otherwise deemed necessary.

This recommendation comes based on the following supporting evidence:

- 1. LifeCare EMS, without any written notice or prior warning, closed its doors on August 9, 2016, leaving the primary provider and Chairman Bell, in the precarious position of fulfilling their scheduled non-emergency runs. During the next 3-4 days, intense scheduling, routing, employee overtime, and MHEMS office personnel phone calls and emails with the clients and vendors sustained all scheduled appointments on date and time (except for two) for treatments such as dialysis and scheduled transports for procedures.
- 2. Several other counties in East Tennessee over the past few years have experienced similar situations with other EMS providers to their county and have closed their counties to outside providers and now only have one County EMS provider. Examples include Grainger County, Jefferson County, and Hawkins County.
- 3. County Commission indicated in their vote on July 24, 2014 "to place no limitations on the number of Certificates of Authority issued for secondary EMS services" to allow competition and free enterprise to determine the feasibility of multiple services operating in Hamblen County. We believe the marketplace has spoken and can financially sustain one (1) patient transportation provider in Hamblen County.
- 4. Morristown-Hamblen EMS responded quickly to take care of the abandoned patients of LifeCare EMS. They have proven capable of handling the 26% increase in non-emergency calls since LifeCare EMS shut its doors. Morristown-Hamblen EMS has stepped up when they were under no obligation to do so and have proven they are here for Hamblen County and its citizens. They have also invested in hiring some of the employees that LifeCare left without a job. Additionally, they have also invested in additional ambulances and equipment to handle the additional call volume.
