WHEREAS, it now appears that the fiscal year 2015 - 2016 budget of Hamblen County, Tennessee, will not be approved by July 1, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Legislative Body of Hamblen County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session on this 18th day of June 2015, that:

SECTION 1. The amount set out in the fiscal 2014 - 2015 Appropriations Resolution are continued and the various departments, offices and agencies are authorized to expend funds at the same level as the previous fiscal year.

SECTION 2. The property tax rate of \$1.64 on each \$100 of taxable property inside the corporate limits of the City of Morristown and \$1.85 on each \$100 of taxable property outside the corporate limits of the City of Morristown for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, will remain in effect until a new property tax rate is adopted.

SECTION 3. No local funds can be expended or obligated that exceed the previous year's budget appropriation until a new budget is adopted. Expenditures mandated by the State or rules and regulations adopted by the State are incorporated into this continuing budget.

SECTION 4. This resolution will take effect from and after its passage and its provisions will be in force from July 1, 2015, until the budget and tax rate for fiscal year 2015 - 2016 is finally adopted and approved. The County Clerk shall include this Resolution in the minutes of the Hamblen County Legislative Body and send a copy to each department head.

A Contract Between the

EAST TENNESSEE DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

AND

HAMBLEN COUNTY, TENNESSEE

PROVIDING FOR LOCAL PLANNING ADVISORY SERVICES

This **CONTRACT**, entered into as of the first day of July, 2015 by the East Tennessee Development District, an agency composed of member governments in mid-east Tennessee, and Hamblen County, Tennessee.

I. <u>FINDINGS & DECLARATIONS</u>

A. <u>Tennessee Code Annotated</u>, §13-14-101 and the following sections establish a delineation of regions deemed viable to the economic development of the state, and allow for the creation of development districts for these regions, encompassing one (1) or more counties or parts of counties, so they are conducive to efficient planning and orderly economic development of the state.

B. <u>Tennessee Code Annotated</u>, §13-14-101 to 13-14-114 established the East Tennessee Development District (ETDD), a public body on behalf of the counties of Anderson, Blount, Campbell, Claiborne, Cocke, Grainger, Hamblen, Jefferson, Knox, Loudon, Monroe, Morgan, Roane, Scott, Sevier, and Union and all incorporated municipalities and metropolitan governments located within these counties.

C. ETDD is empowered, among other duties, "to receive and expend funds from any sources for staffing, for research, planning, coordination, economic development, demonstration projects and other activities deemed necessary to promote the efficient, harmonious and economic development of the region."

D. Hamblen County, Tennessee, requests the ETDD to provide planning advisory services, and agrees to appropriate the necessary funds for these services.

II. <u>CONTRACT</u>

In consideration of these findings and declarations and other valuable considerations, the parties agree as follows:

A. During the twelve (12) month period beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2016, the ETDD agrees to furnish the services of professionally trained planning advisors who will confer with the local planning commission, board of zoning appeals and other local officials with respect to all phases of the comprehensive planning program. Planning recommendations are advisory only; local communities and their appropriate representatives have the sole authority to enact and enforce ordinances and other regulatory tools. A work program derived from the elements listed below will be developed jointly between the ETDD and contracting community within 30 days of the signing of the planning contract by both parties. Other activities may be included depending on the scope and nature of the desired services and ETDD capacity. All activities must be agreed upon mutually by the community and ETDD. Planning services may include but are not limited to the following activities:

1. Attendance at planning commission and/or boards of zoning appeals meetings; assistance in the preparation or review of the long range work program of the planning commission; preparation of comprehensive plans, Public Chapter 1101 Growth Management Plans and amendments, and other planning studies and documents.

2. Preparation of land use controls for adoption, implementation, and enforcement by local community officials, including but not limited to zoning ordinances, subdivision regulations, flood plain management regulations, or other land use controls; review of development proposals; advice and assistance to administrators of zoning, subdivision regulations, and other land use controls.

3. Access to the resources of a regional office including drafting, mapping, and geographic information systems support; planning related research.

4. Specialty training for planning commissions, boards of zoning appeal and local administrators; assistance in providing information on planning activities and interpreting planning programs and activities to the public through meetings and conferences, news releases and presentations before various groups.

5. Advice and assistance on all matters relating to state, federal, and regional programs that affect planning and implementation for the locality.

B. Payment for services provided by ETDD to Hamblen County, Tennessee will be based on the agreed-upon activities requested in Section II.A. For the purpose of providing funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this contract, **IT IS AGREED** that the chief legislative body will pay to the ETDD the sum of \$13,475.00 annually, payable in total upon the effective date of this contract, or in bi-annual installments of \$6,737.50, due and

payable on the first day of July 2015 and the first day of January 2016. The contracting community hereby authorizes the ETDD to apply on the community's behalf for any eligible funds from State sources to supplement the planning contract amount and to use such grant funds to cover the cost of providing planning services to the community.

- **C.** Either party may terminate this contract by giving written notice to the other party specifying the date of termination, at least ninety (90) days before the termination date. Upon termination of the contract, the obligation of the ETDD to conduct and carry on the program agreed to under this Contract shall cease, the financial obligation of the chief legislative body as described in this Contract above likewise ceases. If prepayment has been made by the chief legislative body, the ETDD will determine, by prorating, the amount to be refunded.
- **D.** This contract is for a period of twelve months. A new 12 month contract and fee schedule will be presented for FY 2017. Local governments are under no obligation to continue ETDD planning services beyond the dates specified in this contract.
- **E.** In all matters relating to the performance of this contract, the ETDD Executive Director acts for the ETDD, and the County Mayor acts for Hamblen County, Tennessee.

The parties execute this contract through their duly authorized representatives.

Investment Policy June 2015

I. Objective

The objective of this investment policy is to lend guidance and direction to the county personnel charged with investing idle county funds.

The County Trustee is authorized by state law to invest idle county funds in accordance with guidelines established by the State of Tennessee and the Hamblen County Legislative Body.

The investment program for Hamblen County has these priorities:

- a) Safety The county's idle cash should be invested only in the safest and most secure investments authorized by state statute.
- b) Liquidity The maturities of the investments should be structured to meet the cash flow needs of the County.
- c) Yield The best yield should be obtained after safety and liquidity are attained.

II. Types of Investments

The County Trustee is authorized to invest idle County funds in instruments allowed under state law (TCA 5-8-301). These investments include certificates of deposit, federally-insured money market accounts, U.S. Treasury bills, notes, bonds and other obligations guaranteed as to principle and interest by the United States and any of its agencies. Money market mutual funds are not a permitted investment tool. Other approved investments include:

- a) other obligations of the United States or its agencies under a repurchase agreement for a shorter time than the maturity date of the security if the market value of the security itself is more than the amount of funds invested;
- b) bonds issued by the State of Tennessee or any of its agencies. Any funds invested must be in bonds rated A or higher by any nationally recognized rating service;
- c) the Local Government Investment Pool (LGIP) managed by the State of Tennessee;
- d) nonconvertible debt securities of the following issuers; provided, such securities are rated in the highest category by a least two (2) nationally recognized rating services;
 - i) The Federal Home Loan Bank
 - ii) The Federal National Mortgage Association
 - iii) The Federal Farm Credit Bank
 - iv) The Student Loan Marketing Association

The Hamblen County Trustee may deposit funds using the Certificate of Deposit Account Registry Service (CDARS) or Insured Cash Sweep accounts (ICS) in accordance with T.C.A. 9-1-118. These deposits must fully comply with the standards set forth in said Tennessee Code Annotated.

III. Types of Maturities

Maturities of investments should coincide with the County cash flow needs. A cash flow analysis should be completed annually using data from at least the three previous fiscal years.

The Investment/Audit Committee of the Hamblen County Legislative Body must approve investments with maturities greater than two (2) years. The Investment/Audit committee and the state director of local finance must approve any investments with maturities of five (5) years or greater.

IV. Placement of Investments

The County Trustee's office shall obtain and document at least two proposals from banks or other financial institutions to assure the County receives the highest and best rate of return. Such documentation shall be retained in the official's office for a period of not less than three (3) years.

The institution that is awarded the bid must provide appropriate collateral (105% of principle amount) or be a member of the Bank Collateral Pool managed by the State of Tennessee if the investment exceeds the limits for federal deposit insurance coverage.

At least once every four (4) years and not less than once every term of office, the County Trustee shall evaluate whether its banking services contract should be rebid. The official shall base the evaluation on proposals obtained from at least two banks or other financial institutions. The official shall prepare a written evaluation of the proposals and preserve such evaluations for a period of not less than three (3) years.

V. Internal Control System

The authority to invest idle County funds lies with the County Trustee. Either the chief deputy trustee or the deputy trustee, charged with the bookkeeping duties, may also be required to sign the documents required to open investment accounts.

The County Trustee has the authority to release securities pledged as collateral by financial institutions. Either the chief deputy trustee or the deputy trustee, charged with the bookkeeping duties, is also authorized to release securities in the absence of the County Trustee. The pledged securities can be released if the remaining collateral is sufficient to meet the collateralization requirement.

A history of investments must be maintained for not less than three (3) years to provide an adequate audit trail.

VI. Reporting

The County Trustee must maintain monthly reports:

- a) listing investments by the type of investment, maturity date, CUSIP/account number, coupon interest rate;
- b) listing the total amount of investments with each financial institution with the amount of collateral being held to cover the total deposits at each depository or a statement of whether the institution is a member of the Bank Collateral Pool.

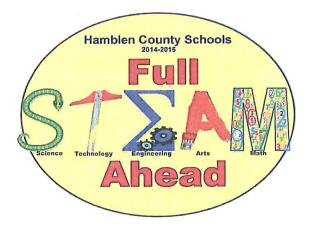
The Hamblen County Board of Education requests approval from the Hamblen County Commission for Amendment #4 to the 2014-2015 General Purpose Budget. This amendment was approved by the Board of Education on May 12, 2015.

On June 26, 2014, the Hamblen County Commission approved a General Purpose Budget in the amount of \$73,487,666.96. Amendment #1 increased the budget to \$73,730,755.57. Amendment #2 increased the budget to \$73,888,397.08. Amendment #3 increased the budget to \$73,965,068.07. Amendment #4 will increase the budget to \$73,975,468.07.

This amendment does not affect the County's maintenance of effort.
