Joint Resolution Hamblen County, Tennessee Hamblen County Commission and Hamblen County Board of Education

A JOINT RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A NONRECURRING (ONE-TIME) APPROPRIATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021 TO FUND NONRECURRING SCHOOL BUSES

WHEREAS, TCA $\S49-3-314(c)(4)$ allows an exemption from Maintenance of Effort requirements for local governments to appropriate funds for educational nonrecurring expenditures of the local education agency (LEA); and

WHEREAS, TCA \$49-3-314(c)(4)\$ section requires a written agreement between the local government and the LEA, which is subject to review by the State Department of Education; and

WHEREAS, the Hamblen County Government fiscal year 2021 budget allocates \$200,000 to the Hamblen County Board of Education for nonrecurring, one-time expenditures to fund nonrecurring school buses.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Hamblen County Board of Education and the Hamblen County Commission hereby agree and acknowledge that the additional \$200,000 in one-time funding allocated to the Hamblen County Board of Education as a part of the fiscal year 2021 budget will be used to fund nonrecurring school buses and shall not be included in the School's Maintenance of Effort calculations pursuant to TCA \$49-3-314(c)(4).

Resolution No. 20-31

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF HAMBLEN COUNTY, TENNESSEE, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE, SALE, AND PAYMENT OF HAMBLEN COUNTY INTERFUND LOAN CAPITAL OUTLAY NOTES, SERIES 2021 NOT TO EXCEED \$300,000

WHEREAS, the County Commission of Hamblen County, Tennessee (the Local Government) has determined that it is necessary and desirable to provide funds for the following public works project: **Payment of Costs for Various Safety Projects around Hamblen County Schools** (the "Project") at a cost of \$300,000 and an economic life of 15 years; and

WHEREAS, the County Commission has determined that the Project will promote or provide a traditional governmental activity or otherwise fulfill a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Parts I, IV, and VI of Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated, local governments in Tennessee are authorized to finance the cost of the Project through the issuance and sale of interest bearing capital outlay notes with a maturity of up to three years upon the approval of the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of §9-21-408 of Title 9 Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated, Local Governments in Tennessee are authorized to make interfund loans in accordance with procedures for issuance of notes in § 9-21-604 of Title 9 Chapter 21 Tennessee Code Annotated.

WHEREAS, the County Commission finds that it is advantageous to the Local Government to authorize the issuance of capital outlay notes to finance the cost of the Project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Commission of **Hamblen County**, Tennessee, as follows:

Section 1. That, for the purpose of providing funds to finance the cost of the Project in and for the Local Government, the **Hamblen County Mayor** of the Local Government is hereby authorized in accordance with the terms of this resolution, and upon approval of the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee, to issue and sell interest-bearing capital outlay notes in a principal amount not to exceed **Three Hundred Thousand Dollars** (\$300,000) (the "Notes") from the **General Debt Service Fund** to the **General Capital Projects Fund** upon approval of the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee pursuant to the terms, provisions, and conditions permitted by law. The Notes shall be designated "**Hamblen County Interfund Loan Capital Outlay Notes, Series 2021"**, shall be numbered serially from 1 upwards; shall be dated as of the date of issuance; shall be in denomination (s) as agreed upon by the legislative governing body; shall be sold at not less than 99% of par value and accrued interest; and shall bear interest at a rate or rates not to exceed **zero** percent (0%) per annum, and in no event shall the rate exceed the legal limit provided by law.

Section 2. That, the Notes shall mature not later than **three**(3) years after the date of issuance and that the Notes and any extension or renewal notes shall not exceed the reasonably expected economic life of the Project, which is hereby certified by the County Commission to be at least 15 years. Provided, however, that each year [or *fiscal year after the fiscal year of issue*] the Notes are outstanding, **one-third** (1/3), [but in no event not less than one-ninth (1/9)], of the original

principal amount of the Notes shall mature without renewal but subject to prior redemption.

Section 3. That, the Notes shall be subject to redemption at the option of the Local Government, in whole or in part, at any time, at the principal amount and accrued interest to the date of redemption, without a premium, or, if sold at par, with or without a premium of not exceeding one percent (1%) of the principal amount.

Section 4. That, the Notes shall be direct general obligations of the Local Government, for which the punctual payment of the principal and interest on the notes, the full faith and credit of the Local Government is irrevocably pledged and the Local Government hereby pledges its taxing power as to all taxable property in the Local Government for the purpose of providing funds for the payment of principal of and interest on the Notes. The County Commission of the Local Government hereby authorizes the levy and collection of a special tax on all taxable property of the Local government over and above all other taxes authorized by the Local government to create a sinking fund to retire the Notes with interest as they mature in an amount necessary for that purpose.

Section 5. That, the Notes shall be executed in the name of the Local Government and bear the manual signature of the **Hamblen County Mayor** and the manual signature of the **Hamblen County Clerk** with the Local Government seal affixed thereon; and shall be payable as to principal and interest at the office of the **County Trustee** of the Local Government or the paying agent duly appointed by the Local Government. Proceeds of the Notes shall be deposited with the **County Trustee** of the Local Government and shall be paid out for the purpose of financing the Project pursuant to this Resolution and as required by law.

Section 6. That, the Notes will be issued in fully registered form and that at all times during which any Notes remains outstanding and unpaid, the Local Government or its agent shall keep or cause to be kept at its office a note register, if held by an agent of the Local Government, shall at all times be open for inspection by the Local Government or any duly authorized officer of the Local Government. Each Note shall have the qualities and incidents of a negotiable instrument and shall be transferable only upon the note register kept by the Local Government or its agent, by the registered owner of the Note in person or by the registered owner's attorney duly authorized in writing, upon presentation and surrender to the Local Government or its agent together with a written instrument of transfer satisfactory to the Local Government duly executed by the registered owner of the registered owner's duly authorized attorney. Upon the transfer of any such Note, the Local Government shall issue in the name of the transferee a new registered note or notes of the same aggregate principal amount and maturity as the surrendered Notes. The Local Government shall not be obligated to make any such Note transfer during the fifteen (15) days next preceding an interest payment date of the Notes or, in the case of any redemption of the Notes, during the forty-five (45) days next preceding the date of redemption.

Section 7. That, the Notes shall be in substantially the form authorized by the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee and shall recite that the Notes are issued pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated.

Section 8. The Notes shall not be sold until receipt of the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee's written approval for the sale of the Notes.

Section 9. That the Notes may be designated as qualified tax-exempt obligations for the purpose of Section 265(b) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

Section 10. That, after the sale of the Notes, and for each year that any of the notes are outstanding, the Local Government shall prepare an annual budget in a form consistent with accepted

governmental standards and as approved by the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee (the "Director".) The budget shall be kept balanced during the life of the notes. The annual budget shall be submitted to the Director immediately upon its adoption; however, it shall not become the official budget for the fiscal year until such budget is approved by the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee in accordance with Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated (the "Statutes".) If the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee determines that the budget does not comply with the Statutes, the County Commission shall adjust its estimates or make additional tax levies sufficient to comply with the Statutes, or as directed by the Comptroller of the Treasury or Comptroller's Designee.

Section 12. That, all orders or resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed insofar as such conflict exists and this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

Both principal of and interest on this note at the office of the Hamblen County Trustee of the Local Government or a paying agent duly appointed by the Local Government in lawful money of the United States of America.

This note is a direct obligation of the Local Government for the payment of which as to both principal and interest the full faith and credit of the Local Government is pledged.

This note is issued under the authority of Parts I, IV, and VI of Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated, and a Resolution duly adopted by the County Commission of the Local Government meeting in session on the 23rd day of July, 2020 (the "Resolution") to provide funds to finance the cost of public works projects referenced in the Resolution.

This note shall have the qualities and incidents of a negotiable instrument and shall be transferable only upon the note register kept by the Local Government or its agent, by the Registered Owner of the note in person or by the Registered Owner's attorney duly authorized in writing, upon presentation and surrender to the Local Government or its agent of the note together with a written instrument of transfer satisfactory to the Local Government duly executed by the Registered Owner or the Registered Owner's duly authorized attorney but only in the manner as provided in the Resolution of the Local Government authorizing the issuance of this note and upon surrender hereof for cancellation. Upon the transfer of any such note, the Local Government or its agent shall issue in the name of the transferee a new registered note or notes of the same aggregate principal amount and maturity as the surrendered note. The Local Government shall not be obligated to make any such Note transfer during the fifteen (15) days next preceding an interest payment date on the Notes or, in the case of any redemption of the Notes, during the forty-five (45) days next preceding the date of redemption.

Title 9, Chapter 21, Section 117, Tennessee Code Annotated provides that this note and interest thereon are exempt from taxation by the State of Tennessee or by any county, municipality or taxing district of the State, except for inheritance, transfer and estate taxes and except as otherwise provided under the laws of the State of Tennessee.

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED, RECITED AND DECLARED that all acts, conditions and things required to exist, happen and be performed precedent to and in the issuance of this note exist, have happened and have been performed in due time, form and manner as required by the Constitution and laws of the State of Tennessee, and that the amount of this note, together with all other indebtedness of the Hamblen County, does not exceed any constitutional or statutory limitation thereon, and that this note is within every constitutional and statutory limitation.

Hotspot Vacation Policy July 2020

Employees who choose to travel on vacation to beaches, tourist destinations, indoor venues, or other attractions where social distancing is not possible are to be tested for COVID-19 upon their return to work and

a) Wear a mask at all times in County Buildings until test results are known

OR

b) Take leave (comp-time, vacation then sick) until test results are known

If an employee chooses not to be tested, he/she cannot return to work for a minimum of 10 calendar days and not show any symptoms of the coronavirus for the last three consecutive days. The employee must take leave paid or unpaid.

If anyone in the immediate traveling party who shared lodging with the employee returns with symptoms, the employee should be tested and not return to work until his/her test results are known. The employee must take leave paid or unpaid during that time.

If the employee's test results are positive, the employee will be asked to quarantine in accordance with the recommendations of the Hamblen County Health Department.

Effective 8/1/2020

Hamblen County Health Department Recommendations Regarding Quarantine for COVID-19 July 2020

A negative test is not required to return to work.

For employees who have a positive test result:

- a) <u>With no symptoms</u>, quarantine for 10 calendar days minimum. If there are no symptoms for the last 3 consecutive days, the person can be released from quarantine. The start date is the date of the test (not the day the test results are learned).
- b) <u>With symptoms</u>, quarantine for 10 days minimum starting with the date symptoms began. If the person exhibits symptoms at 10 days, continue quarantine until the person is symptom free for 3 consecutive days.

For county employees (all are considered "essential workers") who have been in contact with someone who has tested positive:

- c) If symptoms begin, he/she should be tested and quarantine until the test results are learned. If the test result is negative, the person continues the 14-day quarantine with a start date when symptoms began. If the test result is positive, the person is to follow the 10-day rule explained in (b).
- d) If there are no symptoms, he/she should be tested and can return to work wearing a mask until the test results are known. If the test is positive, the person is to follow the 10-day rule explained in (a).
