A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING HAMBLEN COUNTY TO APPLY FOR THE VIOLENT CRIME INTERVENTION FUND GRANT (VCIF) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$179,732

WHEREAS, Gov. Bill Lee and the General Assembly appropriated \$100 million in the State 2022-23 budget for the Violent Crime Intervention Fund (VCIF), which provides grant funds for local law enforcement agencies to implement evidence-based programs, technology, and strategies that will reduce violent crime in our communities.

WHEREAS, the VCIF Grant will support:

- 1) Implementation of programming based on proven effective violent crime intervention models
- 2) Hiring and training of specialized violent crime investigative units
- 3) Purchase and application of new technology and equipment
- 4) Law enforcement led partnerships with community organizations of their choice to directly disrupt or prevent violent crime
- **WHEREAS**, the Hamblen County Commission desires to take advantage of this reimbursable grant where the County will incur the cost and receive reimbursement upon request from the State.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Hamblen County Commission does hereby authorize the County Mayor to prepare an application for the Violent Crimes Intervention Fund Grant (VCIF) in the amount of \$179,732.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that under the Violent Crimes Intervention Fund Grant (VCIF) Hamblen County will incur the cost of the grant and request reimbursement from the State.
