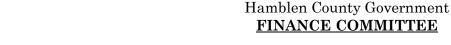

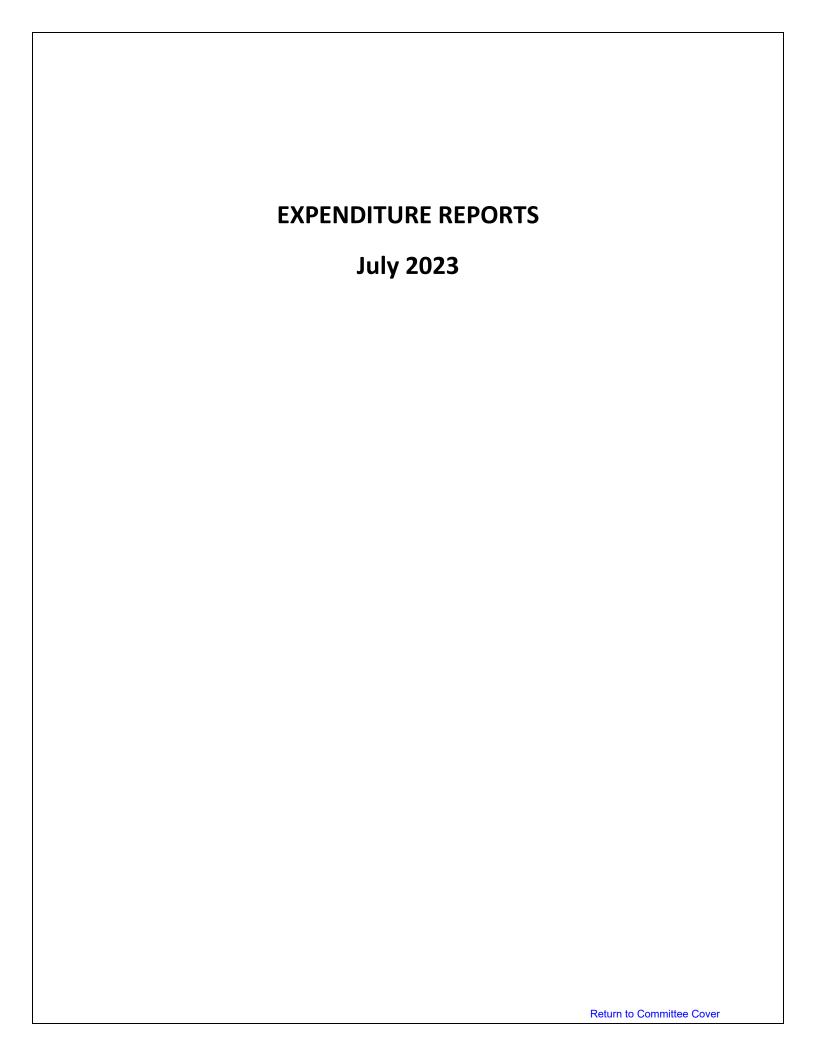

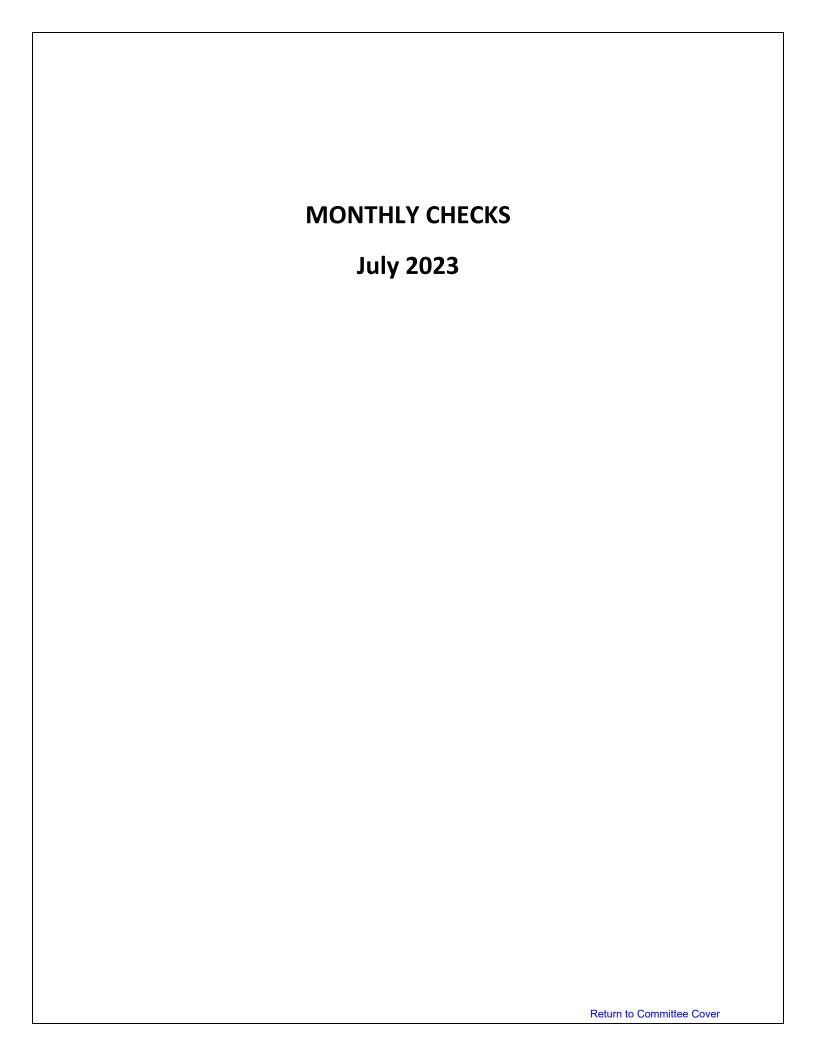

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RESOLUTION 23-

TO LEVY AN ADDITIONAL COUNTY-WIDE MOTOR VEHICLE TAX

WHEREAS, T.C.A. § 5-8-102 authorizes counties to levy a motor vehicle privilege tax, or "wheel tax," as a condition precedent to the operation of a motor vehicle within the county; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the 2002 Hamblen County Wheel Tax Referendum the total motor vehicle privilege tax in Hamblen County currently is twenty-seven dollars (\$27) with proceeds going to any Fund as the Hamblen County Legislative Body determines by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the need for new revenue sources to fund a local paving and road improvements program is great in Hamblen County; and

WHEREAS, the county legislative body of Hamblen County has determined that it is in the best interests of the county that an additional motor vehicle privilege tax in the amount of twenty-three dollars (\$23) be levied in Hamblen County as provided herein, so that the total motor vehicle privilege tax in Hamblen County will be fifty dollars (\$50).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the county legislative body of Hamblen County meeting in regular session at Morristown, Tennessee, on the 24th day of August, 2023 that:

SECTION 1. For the privilege of using the public roads and highways in Hamblen County, Tennessee, there is levied upon motor-driven vehicles, and upon the privilege of the operation thereof, except motorcycles, motor-driven bicycles and scooters, farm tractors, self-propelled farm machines not usually used for operation upon public highways or roads, and motor-driven vehicles owned by any governmental agency or governmental instrumentality, and except for other exemptions provided by general law, a special privilege tax for the benefit of such county, which tax shall be in the amount of twenty-three dollars (\$23) for each such motor-driven vehicle, the owner of which resides within said county. This tax applies to, is a levy upon, and shall be paid on each motor-driven vehicle, the owner of which resides within said county. This tax shall be in addition to all other motor vehicle privilege taxes now levied in Hamblen County.

SECTION 2. The tax herein levied shall be paid to and collected by the County Clerk of Hamblen County, who is authorized by T.C.A. § 67-4-103 to collect such privilege taxes. The County Clerk shall collect this tax at the same time he or she collects the state privilege tax levied upon the operation of a motor-driven vehicle over the public highways of this state, and all other county motor vehicle privilege taxes levied in Hamblen County. The County Clerk shall deduct a fee of five percent (5%), or such higher or lower fee as may from time to time be authorized under T.C.A. § 8-21-701 for receiving and paying over county revenue, from the amount of taxes collected and paid over to the County Trustee.

SECTION 3. Payment of the privilege tax imposed hereunder shall be evidenced by a receipt, issued in duplicate by the County Clerk, the original of which shall be kept by the owner of the motor-driven vehicle, and by the same decal or emblem issued by the County Clerk to evidence payment of all other motor vehicle privilege taxes levied in Hamblen County.

SECTION 4. The privilege tax or wheel tax herein levied, when paid, together with full, complete and explicit performance of and compliance with all provisions of this resolution by the owner, and payment of all other motor vehicle privilege taxes levied in Hamblen County, shall entitle the owner of the motor-driven vehicle for which said tax was paid and on which the required decal or emblem has been affixed to operate or allow to be operated his vehicle over the streets, roads and highways of the county for a period of one (1) year which will run concurrently with the period established by T.C.A. § 55-4-104 for state registration fees.

In the event a wheel tax decal or emblem is sold by the Clerk for a period of more or less than a twelve-month period, the tax imposed shall be proportionate to the annual tax fixed for the vehicle and modified in no other manner, except that the proportional tax shall be rounded off to the nearest quarter of a dollar.

SECTION 5. If any motor-driven vehicle, for which all wheel taxes have been paid and the required decal or emblem issued and placed thereon, becomes unusable or is destroyed or damaged to the extent that it can no longer be operated over the public roads, streets or highways of said county, or in the event that the owner transfers the title to such vehicle, or completely removes therefrom and destroys the decal or emblem issued for and placed thereon, and the owner

makes proper application to the Clerk for the issuance of a duplicate decal or emblem to be used by the applicant on another vehicle for the unexpired term for which the original decal or emblem was issued, and the Clerk is satisfied that the applicant is entitled to the issuance of a duplicate decal or emblem and the applicant pays into the hands of the Clerk the sum of seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50), the Clerk will then issue to such owner a duplicate receipt, cancelling the original receipt delivered to the Clerk by the applicant, and will deliver to the applicant a duplicate decal or emblem, which shall be affixed to the motor-driven vehicle for which it is issued, and such duplicate decal or emblem shall entitle the applicant to operate or allow to be operated the vehicle upon the streets, roads, and highways of said county for the remainder of the period for which the original decal or emblem was issued. Likewise, in the event a decal or emblem becomes obliterated, erased, or defaced, or is destroyed under the provisions of this act, and is therefore illegible and unusable by the owner, upon proper application made by the owner and filed with the Clerk, showing such circumstances and facts to be true, then the Clerk, upon receipt from the applicant of seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50), may issue and deliver to the applicant a duplicate decal or emblem.

SECTION 6. The proceeds of the additional \$23 motor vehicle privilege tax herein levied shall be placed in the County Highway Capital Projects Fund and shall be used to repair and resurface roads, prepare roads and roadbeds for resurfacing, install guardrails, stripe roads, repair bridges and provide matching money for state and federal road improvements programs (such as the state aid program) for roads whose maintenance is the responsibility of Hamblen County Government.

SECTION 7. If any provision of this resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to that end the provisions of this resolution are declared to be severable.

SECTION 8. This resolution shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the County Legislative Body of Hamblen County at two (2) consecutive regularly scheduled meetings.

SECTION 9. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon being approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the County Legislative Body of Hamblen County at two (2) consecutive regularly scheduled meetings. For the purpose of collection of the tax herein levied, such collection shall begin on the first day of December, 2023, unless this resolution is subject to a referendum election pursuant to T.C.A. § 5-8-102, whereupon collection of the tax herein levied shall begin on the first day of the month following the month that this resolution is approved at a referendum.

INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR COUNTY SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER FUNDING

This Interlocal Cooperation Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into this _____ day of _____ 2023 by and between THE CITY OF MORRISTOWN, TENNESSEE ("City") and HAMBLEN COUNTY ("County").

Whereas, the County is establishing a School Resource Officer ("SRO") division in order to provide an SRO at each and every school located in Hamblen County, which result in the hiring of twenty-one (21) SROs,

Whereas, the County will provide a majority of the necessary costs required for the SROs, but is seeking assistance from the City for specific items related to the initial costs for these twenty-one (21) SROs and other recurring costs, and

Whereas, the City supports the implementation of SROs in all of the Hamblen County schools, and does agree to provide funding to the County to cover a portion of the costs associated with same.

Witnesseth, that in consideration of these mutual goals herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. The County agrees to employ individuals to serve as SROs under the County's SRO division and to comply with the requirements associated with the State of Tennessee grants to fund said SROs.
- 2. The City agrees to contribute a total amount of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) over the next two (2) fiscal years to the County. Specifically, the City will contribute one hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000.00) in fiscal year 2023-2024, and another one hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000.00) in fiscal year 2024-2025. This two (2) year financial commitment is provided by the City to the County for the startup of the SRO division.
- 3. The parties agree that the funding amount provided by the City shall be used by the County for the initial equipment costs for the twenty-one (21) SROs as the County determines is necessary, such as equipment, weapon(s), uniform, training for the SROs, and administrative costs, such as insurance coverage for their vehicles and workers' compensation insurance premium costs. It is understood and agreed that the funding provided by the City to the County is for a portion of

- these expenses, and the City is not responsible for the entire costs associated with the above-listed expenses.

- 5. This Agreement shall take effect upon its adoption and approval by the governing bodies of both parties hereto and shall be binding upon the undersigned, their successors and assigns unless modified by an agreement in writing executed by the parties hereto.

INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR COUNTY SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER FUNDING

This Interlocal Cooperation Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into this 24th day of July 2023 by and between THE HAMBLEN COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION ("HCBOE") and HAMBLEN COUNTY ("County").

Whereas, the County is establishing a School Resource Officer ("SRO") division in order to provide an SRO at each and every school located in Hamblen County,

Whereas, the County will provide a majority of the necessary costs required for the SROs, but is seeking assistance from the HCBOE for specific items related to the initial costs and other recurring costs, and

Whereas, the HCBOE supports the implementation of SROs in all of the Hamblen County schools, and does agree to provide funding to the County to cover a portion of the costs associated with same.

Witnesseth, that in consideration of these mutual goals herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. The County agrees to employ individuals to serve as SROs under the County's SRO division and to comply with the requirements associated with the State of Tennessee grants to fund said SROs.
- 2. The HCBOE agrees to contribute a total amount of one million six hundred thousand dollars (\$1,600,000.00) over the next two (2) fiscal years to the County. Specifically, the HCBOE will contribute eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000.00) in fiscal year 2023-2024, and another eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000.00) in fiscal year 2024-2025. This two (2) year financial commitment is provided by the HCBOE to the County for the startup of the SRO division.
- 3. The parties agree that the funding amount provided by the HCBOE shall be used by the County for the initial equipment costs for the SROs as the County determines is necessary, such as equipment, weapon(s), uniform, training for the SROs, and administrative costs, such as insurance coverage for their vehicles and workers' compensation insurance premium costs. It is understood and agreed that the funding provided by the HCBOE to the County is for a portion of these expenses, and the HCBOE is not responsible for the entire costs associated with the above-listed expenses.

- 4. The County agrees to be solely responsible for any and all repairs and maintenance related to the above-listed expenses. Additionally, the County agrees to be solely responsible for any lawsuits and/or claims for damages related to the SROs and the above-listed expenses, and to the extent permitted by law, to hold the HCBOE harmless therefrom.
- 5. Both parties agree to review the terms of this agreement when either party deems it necessary such as when the state law establishing the SRO grant program is amended,
- 6. This Agreement shall take effect upon its adoption and approval by the governing bodies of both parties hereto and shall be binding upon the undersigned, their successors and assigns unless modified by an agreement in writing executed by the parties hereto.

Re: New Position for Soil Conservation District

The Hamblen County Soil Conservation District has requested partial funding for a new position to help landowners and farmers implement conservation technical assistance programs for their properties.

The new position will not only benefit landowners and farmers within the county, but it will also assist our Storm Water Department with its monitoring and testing of streams which TDEC is requiring the county to implement.

The Resource Conservation Technician position will be funded through a partnership among federal, state, and local agencies. A staffing reorganization of the Soil Conservation office will allow Hamblen County to pay for its share of the position for the next two fiscal years without an additional appropriation for the department.

I am recommending that the County enter into the partnership to create the position.

Resource Conservation Technician

Nature of Work

Work will be performed in support of the 2018 Farm Bill and Conservation Technical Assistance (CTA) programs. The technical tasks will generally consist of assisting landowners, collecting data, modifying or preparing limited design adaptations, applying accepted conservation practices, preparing reports, conducting training, and coordinating and communicating with conservationists, engineers, customers, and other NRCS personnel and partners. Work must be completed during the agreement period and be tied to the following programs: Agriculture Resource Conservation Funds (ARCF), Conservation Technical Assistance (CTA), Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EOIP), Agricultural Conservation Easement Program (ACEP), Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP), and Conservation Reserve Program (CRP). Work must identify conservation practices and list individuals assisted in Conservation Desktop. The County technician is required to follow the electronic Field Office Technical Guide (e-FOTG), Section IV Statement of Work for the conservation practices and plans that are completed. The practice documentation guidelines outline the documentation requirements and business tools for planned and applied practices. Job related duties require considerable knowledge of soil conservation and animal waste control practices, strong organizational, interpersonal and decision-making skills and sufficient strength and agility to perform field inspections.

Illustrative Examples of Work

- a) Conservation Planning: Prepare or assist with the preparation of conservation plans in accordance with the National Planning Procedures Handbook (NPPH) and the electronic Field Office Technical Guide (e-FOTG) that address soil, water, air, plant, animal, and other resource concerns that have been identified. All conservation plans must be tied to a conservation program identified in the Scope of Work. The plans must be entered into Toolkit and reviewed by or completed by a certified conservation planner.
- (b) Contract Assistance: Assist landowners/producers with the preparation of contracts for conservation practices/plans approved and funded. The assistance may include development of a time schedule with construction deadlines, quality performance requirements, contract modification support, contract status reviews, project documentation, and payment application support. Completed items will be applied in Conservation Desktop. The County employee must have a level 2 E-Authentication in order to document accomplishments through this system.
- (c) Conservation Practices Application: Prepare guidance to landowners/producers for the application of conservation practices. Practice application includes, but is not limited to, field investigations, topographic site surveying, practice analysis and design, layout, construction inspection, and development of as-built plans. Practices shall include, but are not limited to, those practices shown in this Plan of Work. Practices must

meet the appropriate practice standard and engineering drawings meet the National Engineering Handbook requirements. Include all required signatures.

- (d) Inspect and Verify Conservation Practices: Assist NRCS with the inspection and checkout of conservation practices constructed or being constructed directly for the individual landowner/producer. Inspection shall ensure that work is performed in accordance with approved design, the USDA program contract, and Field Office Technical Guide standards. Employee must perform independent duties only within his/her appropriate job approval authorities.
- (e) Program Support: Provide technical and administrative support, recommendations, and implementation assistance on a wide range of Farm Bill programs. This may include, but is not limited to, conservation planning and application assistance, development of cost lists, ranking criteria, contract development, status reviews, case file management, and general administrative activities.
- (f) Location of Conservation Technical Services: The County shall provide personnel to perform conservation cost-share technical services at the locations listed in this Plan of Work. The work shall be performed in both the field and office environment based on specific task(s) assigned.
- (g) Work Task Reporting: The County must provide information to NRCS regarding their program activities with USDA producers. All progress will be reported in CD.
- (h) Certifications: The contribution agreement employee must work toward obtaining Conservation Planning Certification and Engineering Job Approval Authority for practices applicable to his/her county.

Necessary Requirements of Work

Graduation from an accredited four- year university (Bachelor's Degree preferred) supplemented with additional coursework in soil science; considerable knowledge of natural resources conservation programs and practices;

- -Considerable knowledge of agencies providing natural resource conservation services and information including the USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), National Association of Conservation Districts (NACD), Tennessee Association of Conservation Districts (TACD), Resource Conservation and Development Council (RC&D), etc.
- -Considerable knowledge of required reports and record keeping requirements for compliance with various grants and other resource conservation funded programs.
- -Considerable knowledge of farm plan components, sodbuster requests, sod waterways, diversions, buffer strips, grade control structures, pipe outlets and the installation of animal waste systems.
- -Considerable knowledge of natural resource conservation educational programs and informational materials.
- -Considerable knowledge of computer software programs utilized by the Soil Conservation District including Conservation Desktop, Outlook, Word and Excel.
- -Ability to read and understand soil maps, aerial photos and TOPO maps.
- -Ability to report progress at monthly Soil Conservation District meetings, educational programs, soil judging contests, etc.
- -Ability to interact effectively and maintain productive and professional relationships

with local, state, and federal officials involved in natural conservation activities.

- -Ability to compile and interpret data and related documentation for the preparation of reports and other required documentation.
- -Ability to maintain financial information in an organized manner and consistently and accurately perform accounting transactions in a timely manner.
- -Ability to perform the physically demanding aspects of the job in a variety of weather conditions.
- -Skill in the use of computer hardware components and software applications utilized by the Soil Conservation office.

Necessary Special Requirements

- -Possession of a valid Tennessee Drivers license and the ability to be insured at standard vehicle liability rates.
- -Possession of a valid Official Motor Vehicle Operator's Permit for Non-NRCS Individuals.
- -Ability to pass a Federal Background Check.
- -Completion of Computer Security and Privacy Basics Training annually.

Physical Requirements

- This is light to medium work requiring moderate static, explosive, dynamic and trunk strength and requiring the exertion of up to 50 pounds of force occasionally and up to 10 pounds of force frequently to move objects
- Work requires considerable flexibility, mobility and speed of limb movement
- Work requires moderate effort and stamina
- Work requires both gross body equilibrium and coordination for balancing, bending, stooping, kneeling and walking
- Work requires arm/ hand steadiness and manual and finger dexterity
- Vocal communication is required for expressing or exchanging ideas by means of the spoken word
- Hearing is required to perceive information in both quiet and noisy environments and determine the direction of sounds
- Visual acuity is required for the inspection of small defects and/or small parts, use of measuring devices, operation of office equipment, determining the accuracy and thoroughness of work, color differentiation, and observing general surroundings and activities
- The worker is subject to inside and outdoor environmental conditions

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Additional Potential Responsibilities

- Assists with establishment of stormwater monitoring program/serve as liaison with approved company to handle monitoring of streams
- Conduct inspections at various building projects, specifically for locations in flood zones / stormwater priority sites*
- Assist with performing field inspections/re-inspections of various development sites prior, during, and post-construction to ensure compliance with stormwater regulations
- Assist with compiling data and submitting required Annual Report information with a focus on stream monitoring and inspections of stormwater priority sites*
- Assist with pre-construction meetings for larger developments

*Priority Site (previously known as "hot spot") - means sites, developments, or uses that have the potential of discharging pollutants or concentrations of pollutants that are not normally found in stormwater. These sites could include concrete and asphalt facilities, auto repair, auto supply, and large commercial parking lots.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

AND

MORRISTOWN-HAMBLEN HEALTHCARE SYSTEM

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU") is made this 1st day of October, 2023, by and between the undersigned representatives of HAMBLEN COUNTY, TENNESSEE ("COUNTY"), located at 511 West Second North Street, Morristown, Tennessee 37814 and MORRISTOWN-HAMBLEN HEALTHCARE SYSTEM ("MHHS"), a non-profit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the state of Tennessee, located at 908 West Fourth North Street, Morristown, Tennessee 37814.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, MHHS is a Tennessee not-for-profit hospital that provides a disproportionate share of healthcare services to the Medicare populations in addition to supporting many programs that benefit the indigent, uninsured or underinsured population in East Tennessee.

WHEREAS, MHHS desires to participate in the drug discount program established under Section 340B of the Public Health Service Act (the "340B Program");

WHEREAS, in order to participate in the 340B Program, MHHS must enter into an agreement with a unit of Government pursuant to which MHHS commits to provide healthcare services to low income individuals who are not entitled to Medicare or Medicaid benefits at no reimbursement or considerably less than full reimbursement from these patients;

WHEREAS, MHHS desires to make such a formal commitment to the COUNTY; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY agrees to accept such commitments on behalf of the citizens of Hamblen County and the State of Tennessee.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual agreements and covenants contained therein and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which hereby are acknowledged, it is mutually agreed and covenanted, under seal, by and between the parties to this Agreement, as follows:

Commitment of MHHS to Provide Indigent Care.

During the term of this MOU, MHHS agrees to continue its historical commitment to the provision of healthcare to indigent, uninsured and underinsured residents of Hamblen County and all of East

Tennessee who are not entitled to Medicare or Medicaid benefits through the ongoing operation of the Emergency Department of MHHS. MHHS will provide such services at no reimbursement or considerably less than full reimbursement and will assure that all such patients will receive necessary care, as required by law, in its Emergency Department, regardless of ability to pay.

2. Commitment of MHHS to Submit Quarterly Reports of Calculation and Annual Special Audit.

During the term of this MOU, MHHS agrees, upon written requests from COUNTY, to submit reports of the calculations associated with the 340B Program. COUNTY's requests shall not be made more frequently than on a quarterly basis, and such requests shall specify the timeframe for which said calculations are being sought.

Acceptance and Acknowledgments of COUNTY.

- (a) COUNTY accepts the commitment of MHHS set forth above;
- (b) COUNTY hereby acknowledges that the healthcare services provided by MHHS hereunder are in the public interest and are being provided to individuals who are not entitled to benefits under Title VIII or eligible for assistance under any State plan pursuant to Title XIX of the Social Security Act; and
- (c) COUNTY acknowledges that MHHS is providing these services at no reimbursement or considerably less than full reimbursement from the patients.
- 4. Representations of MHHS. MHHS represents that as of the date hereof:
 - (a) MHHS constitutes a corporation duly organized and validly existing in good standing under the laws of the State of Tennessee with the corporate power and authority to enter into and perform its obligations under this MOU; and
 - (b) MHHS is a tax-exempt corporation under Section 50l(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States, as amended, and under applicable laws of the State of Tennessee.
- 5. Term and termination. The term of this MOU shall commence on the date first above written and shall continue until September 30, 2024 unless cancelled by either party upon not less than sixty (60) days prior written notice to the other.
- 6. <u>Notice.</u> All notices required or permitted to be given under this MOU shall be deemed given when delivered by hand or sent by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed as follows:

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

FY 23 Edward Byrne Memorial (JAG) Program Award

This agreement is made and entered into this 1st day of August, 2023 between the City of Morristown and Hamblen County.

The Morristown Police Department and the Hamblen County Sheriff's Office have agreed to the Evidence Security Upgrade and Processing Program. The goals of this project are to provide upgraded evidence security measures and processing abilities; and

Whereas, this Agreement is made under the authority of Tennessee Code Annotated §§12-9-101; and

Whereas, the City of Morristown and Hamblen County Governments have jointly agreed to the Evidence Security Upgrade and Processing Program and desire to reduce their agreement in writing; now

Therefore, in consideration of the above-stated premises, the City of Morristown and Hamblen County Governments agree to the program as follows:

The Morristown Police Department made 37,800 police contacts in 2022. Detectives investigated 3,880 criminal cases during the year. Patrol officers are responsible for policing 35.61 square miles of service area consisting of 322 miles of roadway. Morristown is recognized as a Metropolitan Statistical Area. The total estimated service population of the Morristown Police Department is 87,602.

The FY 2023 JAG Local Solicitation allocation for Morristown City and Hamblen County is \$18,819. Both units of government have agreed to the Evidence Security Upgrade and Processing Program. This program will include the purchase of a network video camera security and access login system. This project timeline is October 1, 2022-September 30, 2024 as stated in the JAG 2024 Local Solicitation.

The Morristown Police Department (MPD) is the municipal law enforcement agency within Hamblen County with 86 full-time and 11 part-time sworn officers. Officers are responsible for collecting and preserving evidence for prosecution in the municipal, state and federal court systems. The processing and safe storage of evidence is crucial to successful case

adjudication. With awarded JAG funds, an upgraded network video security system with eight cameras and evidence vault access login monitoring will be purchased to help secure approximately 10,000 pieces of evidence currently housed in the MPD evidence control area. Additionally, the MPD will purchase an updated dual temperature cyanoacrylate laboratory fuming chamber to replace antiquated equipment for the processing of latent fingerprints on non-porous surfaces. The Morristown Police Department, as the fiscal agent, will collect the data required for the quarterly accountability metrics at www.bjaperformancetools.org. The goals of this project are to provide upgraded evidence security measures and processing abilities. Performance measures will reflect the purchase, installation, and successful implementation of the equipment into the MPD evidence control and processing procedures.

- 2. The duration of this Agreement shall be for the period of October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024, unless one of the parties hereto provides the other with a sixty (60) days written notice.
- 3. The City of Morristown Financial Director shall serve as the Fiscal Agent for all revenues and expenditures relating to this program.

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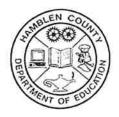

This amendment does not affect the County's maintenance of effort.

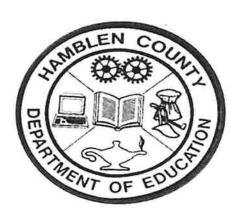

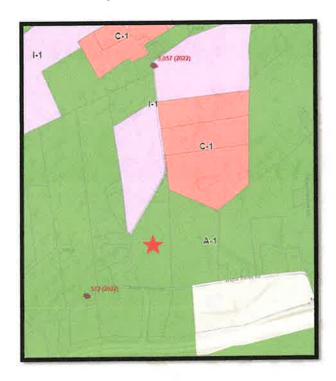
UGB Rezoning from A-1 to I-1

BACKGROUND:

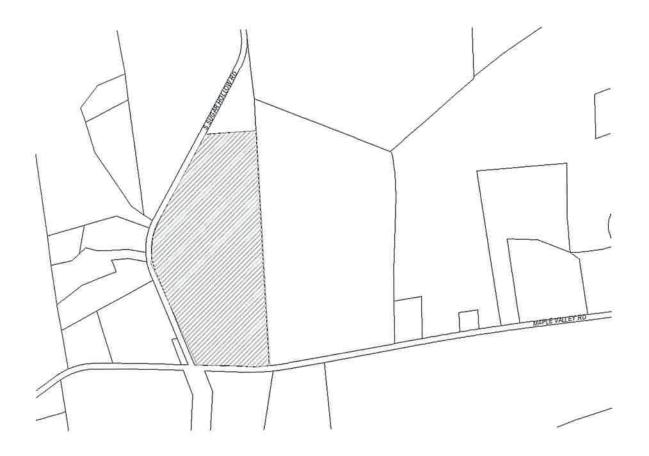
Staff has received a request from applicant, Leslie Jo Deadrick, on behalf of property owners, Joe and Charlotte Long, to rezone a parcel at the northeastern intersection of Maple Valley Road and S. Sugar Hollow Road from Hamblen County zoning A-1, Agricultural-Forestry District, to I-I, Industrial District.

This parcel is currently vacant and contains 12.51 acres. The applicant has noted that they are requesting this in order to place an office and warehouse for a concrete pumping truck business. It does contain I-1 zoning on an adjacent piece of property to the northwest along with similar zoning districts and uses to north on S. Sugar Hollow Road.



RECOMMENDATION:

Due to the proximity of the I-1 district and similar uses along this road, Staff recommends approval of this request as did the Morristown Regional Planning Commission.
